

LAWRENCE UTILITIES PAYMENT OPTIONS

Currently Lawrence Utilities has six water/ sewer/trash collection payment options available for their convenience.

1. 24/7 Payments by phone at 317-542-0511 select make a payment accepts credit card or check payment.

2. 24/7 Web Payments at <u>www.</u> <u>cityoflawrence.org</u> One-time payment with credit card or check

3. 24/7 Account Access at <u>www.</u> <u>cityoflawrence.org</u> Utility Access Portal. Set up recurring payments. **4.** 24/7 Automated Payment Kiosk located at Government Center accepts cash, check, or credit card. (9001 59th Street Located by the Post Road entrance to the parking lot)

5. 24/7 Dropbox located at 9201 Harrison Park Ct. Check or Money Order only. NO CASH PAYMENTS PLEASE.

6. Mail Payment to PO Box 1366 Indianapolis, IN 46206 check or money order.

WATER CONSERVATION TIPS

New toilets are designed to conserve water use. They use only 1.6 gallons per flush. Replacing an older toilet will pay off in the long run through savings on your water bill.

Check for leaks. Toilets are notorious for silent leaks, usually through the flapper valve at the bottom of the tank. Place a few drops of food coloring in the toilet tank and wait 15 minutes without flushing. Look into the toilet bowl to see if the water is colored. If it does, you have a leak, and it should be repaired as soon as possible.

A leak in your toilet can waste thousands of gallons per year. A faucet leaking one drop per second can waste from 2 to 4-thousand gallons per year. Generally, it is preferable to replace your toilet with the new water-saving type instead of displacing water with bricks and other objects. Consider replacing your toilets fill assembly with a dual-action flush feature to flush only liquid waste with a smaller volume of water.

Check your outside spigots frequently to ensure they are off. If you have the kind that can be shut off from inside the home, shut them off inside during the winter months when they are not being used.

Install a water saving or "low-flow" showerhead - they are inexpensive, easy to install and can save thousands of gallons of water per year

Check your water bill monthly to see how much water you are using. Knowing your water use habits will allow you to spot problems before they become larger and more expensive.

INDIANA 811 AND EXCAVATING ON YOUR PROPERTY



Property owners undertaking projects involving excavation, big and small, need to place a call to 811 at least two full working days before you start digging to avoid hitting underground utility lines.

By using Indiana 811's free service and having the approximate location of our members' buried utility lines marked on your property, you can prevent damage to your property, your neighborhood and yourself. Please keep in mind that some lines may require that you contact a private line locating company, which you may find in the yellow pages. Lawrence Utilities does not mark water or sewer service lines on private property. Additionally, irrigation systems and any other lines a property owner may have installed on their property (such as lighting features for landscaping, etc.) also will not be marked under the Indiana811 line locate ticket.
