UNDERSTANDING YOUR LAWRENCE UTILITIES BILL

All Lawrence Utilities bills contain a lot of useful information for the customer about the services provided at that address.

You will see the service address along with the account number for that property. The bill will list your balance as of the previous billing along with the current charges. You will also see any penalties, adjustments, and payments applied to the account. The bill will also show you the consumption that is used to calculate your water and sewer charges.

There can be as little as one and up to three services charged on a Lawrence Utilities bill: water service, sanitary sewer service, and trash fees (for residential customers).

For each service you will see a detailed list of charges that apply to that service and then a total of these charges at the bottom of the bill. If your account is in jeopardy of disconnect the bill will be red. Disconnect dates are always listed on the disconnect bill.

Important information regarding penalties, disconnect challenges and payment options can be found on the back of the bill.

EYE ON WATER - TOOLS FOR NEW WATER METERS

The new meters installed under our meter change out program offers more features to our customers who have had their water meter changed. We offer you direct and secure access to your water usage data.

Visit the City of Lawrence Website and click on the EyeOnWater suite for available tools. The site includes a secure online website to review and analyze your usage patterns and history. A consumer smartphone app will be made available after the initial online sign-up. With these tools, you can view your hourly usage activity, and gain greater understanding and control of the amount of water you use.

Lawrence Utilities EyeOnWater Online provides easy to understand graphs and the ability to establish alerts—including identifying potential leaks. Settings are also available that allow you to have a notification sent to you electronically

when your water usage in a 24-hour period exceeds an amount that you set. This feature provides the best means available at this time for early leak warnings which can save you money and possibly reduce the amount of damage a leak can cause to your property.

2025 CITIZENS POLICE ACADEMY IS ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS

our patrol officers, allowing for a real-life perspective on contemporary policing.

For the selected applicants, the Academy will be held at the Lawrence Police Department, and at the LPD Training Center every Thursday night from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. beginning on March 6, 2025. The academy will be open to individuals who reside or work in the City of Lawrence. Applications will be accepted now through February 7, 2025.
