President Robinson called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

The pledge of allegiance was administered, followed by a prayer given by Council President Betty Robinson.

President Robinson recognized there was a quorum. It was also recognized there were extra copies of the agenda located in the back of the room along with a sign-up sheet for comments from the citizens.

COMMENTS OF COUNCIL MEMBERS: Councilor Masur mentioned, on August 13th, she attended an event sponsored by the Fair Housing Center of Central Indiana. The guest speaker was Brendan Ballou, the author of Plunder Private Equities Plan to Pillage America. She also mentions 46% of the homes sold in Lawrence between 2018 and 2023 were bought with cash. These homes were bought by entities and rented out at exorbitant prices. The homes are not being kept and is harming our community.

Councilor Wells, mentions the 2025 budget and the deficit of this year's budget. He goes on to say we, can't formulate next year's budget until we resolve the deficit that currently exists. Councilor stated he contacted Controller Nagila to inquire into the cost of the recent purchases made by the mayor. Councilor Wells also questioned the Controller about a monthly finance statement that should be provided to the council. He also asked for a summary of bills and wages of the new hires. He will ask the council to move forward with retaining a independent auditor.

President Robinson announced that this proposal was introduced at the July 17th, 2024, council meeting and was sent to the Code and Rules Committee for consideration. She also mentioned the Code and Rules Committee met on this day and are giving a favorable recommendation for Proposal No. 11, 2024. Councilor Chavis made a motion to approve Proposal No. 11, 2024.
